

INFRARED HEATER OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

INTRODUCTION

The CRAFCO INFRARED HEATER was deleloped to heat roadways where repair is required.

DO NOT operated machine without following these instructions.

- 1. Fill Propane Tanks
- 2. Check Engine Crankcase Oil (refer to Engine Operators Manual)
- 3. Check Hydraulic Fluid Level at Ambient Temperature. Add if necessary to bring fluid to correct level.
- 4. All LPG Valves should be in Closed Position.
- 5. Check Battery Voltage.
- 6. Loosen Drive Wheel Retainer Nuts, swing wheel into lowered position and retighten Retainer Nuts.
- 7. Open LPG Tanks as required.
- 8. Start Engine.
- 9. Check Power Wheel Operation.
- 10. Raise Tongue Jack for Operation of Unit.
- 11. Remove Lock Pins from Heater Panels.
- 12. Light Heater Panels:
 - A.) Light Hand Torch.
 - B.) Open Required LPG Manifold Control Valve.
 - C.) Open individual Infrared Heaters as required.
 - D.) Move flame from Hand Torch across Heaters until required Heaters are lit.
 - E.) LPG Pressure should be set between 4 to 6 PSI.
- 13. Lower Panels:
 - A.) Always lower Front Panel first when both panels are to be used. (Refer to page. 10 & 15 Items 21, 22.)
 - B.) Panels must be clear of ground when relocating Infared Heater.

CAUTION: DO NOT raise front heater panel above frame when heater is lit.

- 14. Heat pavement surface until asphalt is thoroughly heated and softened (generally between 5 to 10 minutes depending on pavement conditions.)
- 15. Raise panel, check condition of heated surface, and add new product as required.
- 16. Move to next required repair.

SHUTDOWN

- 1. Close LPG Manifold Valves.
- 2. Close individual Heater Valves.
- 3. Raise Heater Panels and Pin with Lock Pin.
- 4. Lower Tongue Jack and return Drive Wheel to the Travel Position.
- 5. Shut Engine Off.
- 6. Close LPG Tank Valves.

SERVICE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Conduct a general inspection of your machine at least once a week. Replace all worn or damaged parts, make any necessary adjustments and tighten all loose nuts or screws.
- 2. Follow recommended maintenance procedures on maintenance chart.

MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

ENGINE:

Check oil every 8 hours of operation. Change after the first 5 hours of operation and change every 25 hours thereafter.

See engine owners manual for additional operating and maintenance instructions.

HYDRAULIC SYSTEM:

Check hydraulic fluid every 8 hours. Change hydraulic filter after first 10 hours of operating and every 250 hours thereafter. Change hydraulic fluid every 500 hours of operation.

WHEEL BEARINGS:

Repack wheel bearings every 24,000 miles or every two years, using a good grade of bearing grease.

TONGUE JACK:

Lubricate tongue jack, using a good grade of bearing grease.
